To date, fiscal year 2019 (June 1,2018 to January 31, 2019) volunteers at the DCCS office have given 41 hats/turbans and/or scarves; 58 wigs; 12 breast prosthesis and/or bras. Our volunteers also assisted 416 visitors and answered 259 telephone calls. During this time, our volunteers have logged 1,657.67 hours.

During this time period, Douglas County cancer patients came to us with 10 types of cancer including brain, breast, bladder, bone, lymph node, bowel, stomach, cervical, colon, esophageal, genetic hemochromatosis glioblastoma, leukemia, large cell lymphoma, liver, lung, macroglobulinemia, malignant neoplasm of cloacogenic zone, myeloma, oral, ovarian, tongue, pancreatic, peritoneal, prostrate, rectal, shunt, thyroid, tonsil and lymphnode, uterine and waldenstroms macroglobulinoma cancers.

It is an honor to assist cancer patients, ease their burden and allow for them to focus on healing.
