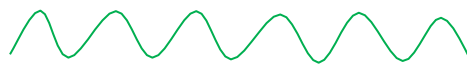

## OUR MISSION...

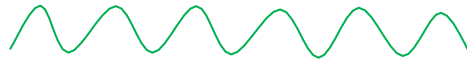

## WHAT WE NEED...

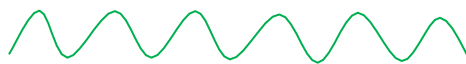

## WHAT WE DO...

### Where the Money Goes / Fiscal Year 2020- June 1, 2019 to February 29,2020

Christmas Dinners for cancer patients	\$ 4,159
Gas cards for transportation	\$ 3,625
Food Cards for groceries	\$ 6,900
Financial aid (rent, utilities, misc.)	\$21,171
<b>Total</b>	<b>\$35,855</b>

For fiscal year 2020 (June 1, 2019 to February 29, 2020) volunteers at the DCCS office have given 110 hats/turbans and/or scarves; 87 wigs and 38 breast prosthesis and/or bras. Our volunteers also assisted 1017 visitors and answered 429 telephone calls. Our volunteers logged 1,029.50 hours.

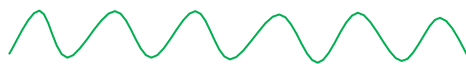
During this time period, Douglas County cancer patients came to us with many different types of cancer including breast, brain, bladder, cervical, colon, endometrial, esophageal, follicular lymphoma, leukemia, lymphoma, liver, lung, larynx, mal neoplasm, mesothelioma, multiple myeloma, neck, ovarian, non-Hodgkin’s lymphoma, pancreatic, prostate, rectal, stomach, uterine and waldenstroms macroglobulinemia.

It is an honor to assist cancer patients, help to ease their burden and allow for them to focus on healing.

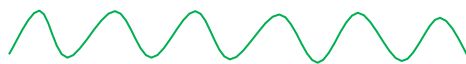
