WHAT WE DO...

Where the Money Goes Fiscal Year 2020/ June 1, 2019 to October 31, 2019

Christmas Dinners for cancer patients (partial) \$ 2,765
Gas cards for transportation \$ 2,175
Food Cards for groceries \$ 4,700
Financial aid (rent, utilities, misc.) \$ 9,125.

Total \$18.765

For fiscal year 2019 (June 1, 2019 to October 31, 2019) volunteers at the DCCS office have given 44 hats/turbans and/or scarves; 57 wigs and 19 breast prosthesis and/or bras. Our volunteers also assisted 593 visitors and answered 265 telephone calls. Our volunteers logged 1,269.40 hours.

During this time period, Douglas County cancer patients came to us with many different types of cancer including breast, brain, cervical, esophageal, follicular lymphoma, leukemia, lymphoma, liver, lung, mesothelioma, multiple myeloma, neck, ovarian, non hodgkins lymphoma, pancreatic, prostrate, rectal, skin, stomach, uterine and waldenstroms macroglobulinoma.

It is an honor to assist cancer patients, help to ease their burden and allow for them to focus on healing.
